Fall COVID Guidelines

These are based on the CDC, State of Colorado, and Tri County COVID – 19 suggested guidelines.

Dancers and Families!

We are so incredibly excited to have you all back at the studio for another fantastic dance season here at Starstruck. Although things may look slightly different than they have in the past, our love for our students and teaching dance has not changed. We can't wait to see your bright and shining faces in the studio and we are so excited to kick off our dance season with you all! Below, you will see a few guidelines that have been put in place to ensure your student's health and safety while they are at the studio doing what they love 😊

- We will utilize space in each studio and mark spots on the floor to keep dancers 6 ft apart.
- Please wear a mask into the studio and in hallways. We will follow state mask orders if in place.
- Please stay in your car until 5 min before your class start time.
- Please arrive in dance clothes ready for class, there will be no changing at studio for classes. Please bring a water bottle.
- Dancers will follow arrows in a circular flow as they change studios and will take their bags/water bottles with them to class.
- As dancers enter the studio, they will use hand sanitizer and their temps will be taken. They will follow the arrows to keep traffic flowing in the same direction.
- The lobby will remain closed along with the dressing rooms, kitchen, and homework room. Dancers will not be able to wait in the studio if they have time in between classes. If you have questions please call Staci during front desk office hours Mon – Thurs 4:30-9:30 pm, Fri 4:30-6:30 pm.
- No make up classes can be done in studio. Make up classes can be done in virtual classes from home. Please contact Staci at the front desk to set up a make up class.
- Cleaning and sanitizing spaces routinely and thoroughly throughout the day. We will have volunteers cleaning frequently touched surfaces continuously throughout the evening.
- All classes must be registered for online thru your portal so we can monitor the number of people in class.
- Both bathrooms will be used to limit the number of people in the bathroom, no more than 1 person in the bathroom at a time. Volunteers will monitor this throughout the evening.
- All barres, yoga blocks, or stretch bands will be wiped down after each use.
- If you or someone in your household does not feel well or has had contact with someone not feeling well please stay home.
